

The Bobbies will be competing at the Imperial Convention in July and are excited to defend their title as the Damndest Unit in the Shrine.



We have had a lot of questions lately about who exactly we support and what we do for the hospital, so I feel this is a good time to go over who we are. Elissa is one of four Guilds who make up the Imperial Council Shrine Guilds of America. We are a ladies organization whose objective is the independent support and aid to Shriners Children's. Our focus for our donations is the Care and Comfort Fund that supports patients and their families. The four Guilds donations go to the Care and Comfort Fund of the Imperial Council which add these donations to the amount of money that has been earned by the Council's investments and is then donated to Shriners Children Ohio, Shriners Children Chicago, and recently Shriners Childrens Lexington. These locations were chosen due to the location of the four Guilds. In the past three years the Imperial Council has made multiple donations, with one being a \$25,000 donation to sponsor a patient exam room at Shriners Childrens Ohio and a donation of \$47,423 divided among the 3 hospitals. In addition to our yearly donations, with Shriners Hospital Ohio opening in Dayton three years ago we collect monthly donations based on the needs of the hospital that range from chalk for drawing to birthday boxes to help families celebrate their child's birthday while in the hospital.
