His tireless work has strengthened fellowship, fostered charitable outreach, and inspired countless brethren. His Masonic resume reflects not just positions held, but a life lived in the service of others—embodying the Scottish Rite's core values of integrity, service, and brotherly love.

The 33rd degree is not a rank sought after, but a recognition bestowed upon those whose dedication stands out among their peers. Al Johnson's selection for this high honor is a reflection of the respect he has earned across the Masonic fraternity. # ANTIOCH SHRINE GOLF CLUB


