At the Imperial Session this year, the Representatives voted to increase the Per Capita tax to \$50 per year from the \$30 it had been. This increase is effective with the 2024 dues cycle. If you elect to pay your lifetime Per Capita prior to Dec 31st, 2023, you can still get it for \$900. After that the price goes to \$1500.

As you get older you will need to do the math on how long it will take to make the difference, plan accordingly.

**Car Safety Tips:** We are now heading into the Winter season, and it is getting darker earlier. Here are a few safety tips to remember:

- 1- Allow time to start your vehicle and let it warm up. This will help with clearing of windows as well as allow vehicle's cooling system to come up to temperature.
- 2- Make sure all lights and signals are working properly, which will require you to do a "walk around" to physically see all the lights.
- 3- Make sure windows are clear and wiper blades are functioning properly. Blades dry out with age, so they won't clear a window very well.
- 4- Walk around and physically check tires for wear as well as making sure they're inflated properly. Don't forget to make sure your spare is in good shape as well so you don't have to find out it's not, when it's inclement weather, cold, and you really need it.
- 5- It's getting darker earlier so try not to refuel, go to ATM, or anything else that would make you need to get out of your car after dark. Do those things in the daylight hours. If you must be out doing errands at night, pay attention to your surroundings.
- 6- Heads up and phones down.....


